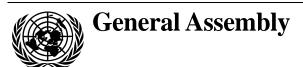

# Report of the Secretary-General

### **Summary**

# I. Introduction

- 1. The present annual report of the Secretary-General on the composition of the Secretariat is submitted pursuant to General Assembly resolutions concerning human resources management, the most recent of which are resolutions 57/305, 59/266, 60/238, 61/244, 63/250, 65/247 and 66/234.
- 2. This report contains a demographic analysis of the global staff of the Secretariat, which totalled 42,887 as at 30 June 2012.
- 3. Table 1 provides an overview of the structure of the report by section, including demographic variables. Table 2 affords an overview of trends by demographic variable from 2008 to 2012. A summary of the major changes in information that have occurred since the preparation of the 2011 report (A/66/347) is shown in table 3. Table 4 shows the number of staff in the Secretariat and related entities in the United Nations system.

### "HR Insight"

- 4. In August 2011, the Office of Human Resources Management launched the first release of an online reporting tool, "HR Insight", that is available to all permanent missions. It is based on the human resources data warehouse and enables the retrieval of information from other human resources systems, including IMIS and Nucleus.
- 5. The first release of the tool provided permanent missions with reports on desirable ranges, a staff list and staff details for their respective nationals, such as composition by gender, and type of appointment. Those online reports are updated on a monthly basis (with approximately a three-month time lag) and can be downloaded, enabling permanent missions to gain convenient, instant access to

often-requested reports from the Office of Human Resources Management and reducing the need to print and distribute printed copies. As such, the tool helps make the United Nations more environmentally friendly, for example the list of staff of the Secretariat is now available online exclusively on this platform, which saves more than 1.2 million pages of paper per year. At the time that the present report was prepared, there were just over 200 users in permanent missions who, in the period from 1 January 2012 to mid-August 2012, had used the tool to produce nearly 3,000 reports.

6. Since the first release of the tool, the Office of Human Resources Management has made a number of enhancements, including adding reports that show Member States their respective nationals' separations, appointments and forecasted retirements plus forecasted retirements of all P-5 to D-2 staff. Member States now have access to reports that are similar to the composition of the Secretariat report, with HR Insight showing mainly information at the level of staff members in contrast to the composition of the Secretariat report, which shows the information at the aggregated level and is produced only annually. Going forward, the Office will work to publish more of the composition of the Secretariat report online.


### II. All staff of the Secretariat

### A. Population

- 7. The total population of the staff of the Secretariat<sup>2</sup> as at 30 June 2012 was 42,887, comprising all categories of staff holding permanent/continuing, fixed-term and temporary contracts, recruited both internationally and locally.<sup>3</sup>
- 8. The "all staff" population includes staff members from 188 Member States (see annex, table 1.A).
- 9. Figure I below shows the five-year trend for all staff in total and by non-field (departments/offices, regional commissions, tribunals) versus field operations. Table 5 details changes in the number of staff from 30 June 2011 to 30 June 2012.

### B. Entity

10. All staff of the Secretariat are employed in four entity groups (departments/ offices, regional commissions, tribunals and field operations). Field offices of the Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs, the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime and other departments/offices are included in their respective

departments/offices. Field operations<sup>4</sup> refer to peacekeeping missions and certain special political missions. Table 1.B (see annex) details the respective entities in the four groups and their staff, showing departments/offices by headquarters and other locations.






# Distribution of staff of the Secretariat in the Professional and higher categories by grade as at $30 \ \text{June}\ 2012$

(Population: 12,289 of 42,887)





 $Figure\ V\\ \textbf{Distribution of staff of the Secretariat in the General Service and related categories by grade as at 30 June\ 2012}$ 





(Population: 42,887)









(Population: 42,887 as at 30 June 2012)




(Population: 42,887)




 $\label{eq:Figure XIII} \textbf{Distribution of staff of the Secretariat in non-field operations by age and gender as at 30 June 2012}$

# A. Population

27. Section III provides an analysis of the movements of the staff of the Secretariat, both external (appointments and separations) and internal (promotions and transfers). The population used in reporting on staff movements, which was 27,383 as at 30 June 2012, includes only staff members administered by IMIS. This population is smaller than that reported in section II on the all-staff population (42,887) because 15,5048 staff of the Secretariat are not recorded in IMIS. This is mainly because most field operations do not have access to IMIS. Table 14 below provides a summary of staff movements.

In section VIII of its resolution 57/305, the General Assembly approved the proposal of the Secretary-General on the placement of staff members serving in the Executive Office of the Secretary-General (see A/56/816) and requested him to report on the implementation of the procedure. During the period from 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012, three staff members were transferred from the Executive Office of the Secretary-General to posts at the same level in another department.

#### D. Gender

33. Table 19 provides a summary of staff movements by gender.

#### E. Age

#### 1. Separations

34. For the period from 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012, the average age of staff of the Secretariat at the time of resignation was 40.4 years. At the time of resignation, the average length of service in the Secretariat was 3.6 years, and 6.2 years in the United Nations common system.

#### 2. Appointments

35. Figure XV shows that most appointed staff are in the 30- to 34-year-old age group.

# IV. Staff subject to the system of desirable ranges<sup>9</sup>

#### A. Population

(Population: 3,814)

36. As at 30 June 2012, there were 2,245 Secretariat staff with geographical status pursuant to paragraph 66 of General Assembly resolution 65/247, in which the Assembly decided that staff members should retain geographical status only when serving against a post subject to geographical distribution, except those recruited under the young professionals programme.

- 37. That provision in resolution 65/247 represents a change in the criteria for geographical status. Prior to 2011, once geographical status had been given, it was retained throughout the period of uninterrupted service of the staff member, regardless of the nature of the position or functions to which the staff member might subsequently be assigned (see A/65/305/Add.2, para. 20).
- 38. The representation of Member States falls into four groups: unrepresented; underrepresented; within range; and overrepresented. A Member State is considered "unrepresented" when not a single one of its nationals, after having gone through the established selection process, is serving in a post subject to geographical

distribution. It is "underrepresented" when the number of its nationals appointed to such posts is below the lower limit of the desirable range; it is "within range" when the number of its nationals appointed to such posts is between the upper and lower limits of the desirable range; and it is "overrepresented" when the number of its nationals appointed to such posts exceeds the upper limit of the desirable range.

39. The representation of Member States under the system of desirable ranges over the past five years is shown in table 20. Table 21 shows the representation status of individual Member States as at 30 June 2012. The representation status of the Member States at 30 June 2011 is indicated if it is different from that as at 30 June 2012. Table 2.A (see annex) provides a detailed breakdown of Secretariat staff with geographical status by nationality, grade and gender, including information on appointments, separations and balances as at 30 June 2011 and 30 June 2012. Table 2.C provides a breakdown of staff in posts with special language requirements by nationality, grade and gender.

#### D. Appointments

44. From 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012, 247 Secretariat staff, after having gone through the selection process, were appointed to posts subject to geographical distribution. Of the 247 Secretariat staff newly appointed to geographical posts, 79 were appointed through national competitive examinations (30 female and 49 male) and 12 Secretariat staff (7 female and 5 male) were appointed through the competitive examination for recruitment to the Professional and higher categories of staff from other categories ("G to P" examination).





- 52. From 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012, 60 Secretariat staff with geographical status retired (27 Directors and 33 staff in the Professional category).
