Draft decision submitted by the extended Bureau

Organization of work for the future sessions of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime*

At its 10th meeting, on 19 October 2012, the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime decided that:

1. For future sessions of the Conference, starting with the seventh session, the firm deadline for the submission of draft resolutions will be two weeks prior to the commencement of the session. The deadline for the submission of draft resolutions emanating from the working groups, which are held concurrently with the plenary session of the Conference, will be on Thursday at noon, provided that the duration of the Conference is five working days.

2. For future sessions of the Conference, starting with the seventh session, the Conference will be preceded by informal pre-session consultations, without interpretation, to be held on the working day preceding the first day of the Conference. The informal pre-session consultations will provide an opportunity for States to engage in informal consultations on draft resolutions and, inter alia, the provisional agenda for the subsequent session of the Conference.
