Algeria:* draft resolution

South-South cooperation

The General Assembly,

Reaffirming its resolution 64/222 of 21 December 2009, in which it endorsed the Nairobi outcome document of the High-level United Nations Conference on South-South Cooperation,¹

Recalling its resolutions 33/134 of 19 December 1978, 57/270 B of 23 June 2003, 60/212 of 22 December 2005, 62/209 of 19 December 2007, 63/233 of 19 December 2008, 64/1 of 6 October 2009, 64/221 of 21 December 2009, 66/219 of 22 December 2011 and other resolutions relating to South-South cooperation,

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General on the state of South-South cooperation;²
2. *Also takes note* of the report of the High-level Committee on South-South Cooperation at its seventeenth session³ and endorses the decisions contained therein;⁴
3. *Encourages* all United Nations organizations, specialized agencies, funds and programmes, as well as the regional commissions, to take concrete measures to effectively mainstream support to South-South and triangular cooperation in their policy and regular programming work, and in this context, requests those organizations and the United Nations Office for South-South Cooperation to leverage each other's institutional and technical capacities;

4. *Urges* the United Nations Office for South-South Cooperation to take extra efforts to mobilize additional resources to meet the increased demand from Member States for the funding of South-South initiatives, especially those designed to address challenges of common concern with the aim of benefiting a large number of countries, and in this regard, encourages all countries in a position to do so, to contribute generously to the United Nations Fund for South-South Cooperation and the Pérez-Guerrero Trust Fund for South-South Cooperation;

5. *Decides* to hold the eighteenth session of the High-level Committee on South-South Cooperation from 19 to 23 May 2014, to be preceded by an organizational meeting on 3 May 2014 to elect the President of the Bureau of the eighteenth session of the High-level Committee;

6. *Also decides* to include in the provisional agenda of its sixty-eighth session, under the item entitled “operational activities for development”, the sub-item entitled “South-South cooperation”, and requests the Secretary-General to submit to it, at the session, a comprehensive report on the state of South-South cooperation.
