I. Introduction

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 21 September 2012, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-seventh session the item entitled:

"Globalization and interdependence:

- "(a) Globalization and interdependence;
- "(b) International migration and development"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 11th meeting, on 18 October 2012. An account of the Committee's discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary record (A/C.2/67/SR.11).
