

Adoption of the agenda

Threats to international peace and security caused by terrorist acts

The President (*spoke in Arabic*): The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them documents S/2012/928 and S/2012/929, which contain, respectively, the texts of two draft resolutions.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. I shall now first put to the vote the draft resolution contained in document S/2012/929, which was submitted by France, Portugal, Togo, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

A vote was taken by show of hands.
