Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 22nd meeting, on 6 November 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/32) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/39/L.10/Rev.l. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.22).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 86 to 2, with 17 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/39/L.10/Rev.1, conference-servicing requirements would arise that are estimated on a full-cost basis at \$41,400. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.
