Programme budget implications of draft resolution H recommended  
by the First Committee (A/39/749, para. 67)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 44th meeting, on 7 December 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/33) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution H recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 67 of its report (A/39/749) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/39/7/Add.8).
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.44).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 65 to 15, with 4 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution H recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 67 of its report (A/39/749), an additional appropriation of \$146,500 would be required under a new sub-section C of section 2B of the programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985.

4. The voting was as follows:

In favour: Afghanistan, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Botswana, Brunei Darussalam, Burkina Faso, Burma, Burundi, Central African Republic, Chad, China, Comoros, Congo, Costa Rica, Cuba, Democratic Yemen, Denmark, Egypt, Ethiopia, Finland, Ghana, Greece, Honduras, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Iraq, Ireland, Ivory Coast, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Maldives, Mauritania, Mexico, Morocco, Mozambique, New Zealand, Norway, Oman, Pakistan, Panama, Portugal, Romania, Singapore, Somalia, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Thailand, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, Uganda, United Arab Emirates, United Republic of Tanzania, Venezuela, Yemen, Yugoslavia, Zaire, Zambia.

Against: Bulgaria, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Czechoslovakia, France, German Democratic Republic, Germany, Federal Republic of, Hungary, Japan, Mongolia, Netherlands, Poland, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining: Belgium, Canada, Israel, Italy.

5. Statements in explanation of vote were made by the representatives of the United States of America, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Japan, Romania and Cuba.

6. The representatives of Algeria, Ecuador and Mali indicated that they had intended to vote in favour.
