Programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended
by the First Committee (A/39/743, para. 8)

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Ali Achraf MOJTAHED (Islamic Republic of Iran)

1. At its 44th meeting, on 7 December 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/74) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/39/743). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.44).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 68 to 7, with 17 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/39/743), an additional appropriation of \$43,500 would be required under section 2B.C of the programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985.

4. The voting was as follows:

In favour: Afghanistan, Algeria, Argentina, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Bulgaria, Burkina Faso, Burma, Burundi, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Cameroon, Central African Republic, China, Congo, Cuba, Czechoslovakia, Democratic Yemen, Egypt, Ethiopia, German Democratic Republic, Ghana, Greece, Guinea-Bissau, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Iraq, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Malaysia, Maldives, Mali, Mauritania, Mexico, Mongolia, Morocco, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, Oman, Pakistan, Panama, Poland, Qatar, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, Thailand, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, Uganda, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Arab Emirates, United Republic of Tanzania, Venezuela, Yemen, Yugoslavia, Zambia.

Against: France, Germany, Federal Republic of, Israel, Japan, Netherlands, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Chile, Denmark, Dominican Republic, Finland, Ireland, Italy, Ivory Coast, Malawi, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden.

5. Statements in explanation of vote were made by the representatives of Israel, the United States of America and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

6. The representative of Ecuador indicated that he had intended to abstain.
