Report of the Fifth Committee

- At its 44th meeting, on 7 December 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/72) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/C.3/39/L.58. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/C.3/39/L.58, conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$147,700. The actual additional appropriation that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.
