PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1984-1985

Programme budget implications of draft resolutions I and II recommended by the Third Committee (A/39/700, para. 69)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 44th and 45th meetings, on 7 and 11 December 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statements by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/71 and A/C.5/39/72) on the programme budget implications of draft resolutions I and II recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 69 of its report (A/39/700). The Committee also had before it the observations of the Committee on Conferences on draft resolution I (A/C.5/39/71/Add.1) submitted in accordance with paragraph 6 of General Assembly resolution 35/10 A. The related reports of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/39/SR.44 and 45).

DECISIONS OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

A. <u>Measures to improve the situation and ensure the human</u> rights and dignity of all migrant workers

3. With regard to draft resolution I recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 69 of its report (A/39/700), the Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution, conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$537,600. The actual additional appropriation that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session. Adoption of the draft resolution would furthermore constitute authorization for an exception to be made to the provisions of paragraph 4 of section I of General Assembly resolution 31/140.

B. <u>Question of the international legal protection of the</u> <u>human rights of individuals who are not citizens of</u> <u>the country in which they live</u>

4. With regard to draft resolution II recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 69 of its report (A/39/700), the Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution, conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$147,700. The actual additional appropriation that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.
