Report of the Fifth Committee

I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 1984, the General Assembly decided, on the recommendation of the General Committee, to include in its agenda and to allocate to the Fifth Committee the item entitled:

"Joint Inspection Unit: reports of the Joint Inspection Unit".

- 2. The General Assembly decided to allocate this item to the Fifth Committee on the understanding that the reports of the Joint Inspection Unit dealing with subject-matters assigned to other Main Committees would be referred also to those Committees.

- 4. The Committee considered this item at its 26th, 31st, 35th, 38th and 53rd meetings, on 13, 20, 27 and 29 November and 15 December. Comments and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/39/SR.26, 31, 35, 38 and 53).

II. CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS

5. At its 53rd meeting on 15 December, the representative of the <u>Bahamas</u> introduced draft resolution A/C.5/39/L.25 (also relating to item 112) and orally revised the draft resolution by adding, under section III, a new preambular paragraph which read as follows:

"Taking into account the views expressed during the debate in the Fifth Committee".

6. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.5/39/L.25, as orally revised, without a vote (see para. 7).

III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

7. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Administrative and Budgetary Co-ordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency

ANNUAL REPORT

Having considered the report of the Joint Inspection Unit on its activities during the period 1 July 1983 to 30 June 1984, 2/ the work programme of the Unit for 1984 3/ and the report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the recommendations of the Unit, 4/

Recalling the fundamental role of the Joint Inspection Unit in the independent investigation and evaluation of activities undertaken by organizations for efficiency of services, proper use of funds and improved management and methods to achieve greater co-ordination between organizations,

Recalling further its resolution 38/229 of 20 December 1983,

- 1. Takes note with appreciation of the annual report of the Joint Inspection Unit and the report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the recommendations of the Unit:
- 2. Renews its invitation to United Nations organs, when considering reports of the Joint Inspection Unit, to bear in mind the importance of specific, clear decisions on the recommendations contained in the Unit's reports for effective follow-up action by the Unit;
- 3. Requests the Joint Inspection Unit, when preparing its annual programme of work, to concentrate, to the greatest extent possible, on those areas which are of greatest importance and relevance within the United Nations system;
- 4. <u>Invites</u> the Joint Inspection Unit to include, in its annual report to the General Assembly on its programme of work, the basis for the selection of each study;
- 5. Requests the Secretary-General to ensure that the reports of the Joint Inspection Unit, together with the comments of the Secretary-General thereon, are provided on a regular basis to the appropriate subsidiary organs of the General Assembly for review;
