## DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND MEASURES OF IMPLEMENTATION

Uruguey: revised emendment to the arendment submitted by the United States of America (E/CN.4/L.81)

Revise article 30 to read as follows:

"1. The States Parties to the Covenant recognize the right of everyone to ensure the development of science and culture in any way that is not contrary to the principles of democracy and the maintenance of peace and co-operation between peoples.

"2. They recognize that it is one of their principal aims to ensure conditions which will permit everyone:

- "(a) To take part in cultural life;
- "(b) To enjoy freedom necessary for scientific research and creation;
- "(c) To enjoy the benefits of scientific progress and its applications.

"3. The full attainment of this right requires the conservation, the development and the diffusion of science and culture."
