### DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND MEASURES OF IMPLEMENTATION

# Polend: amendment to the emendment submitted by the United States of America (E/CN.4/L,81)

- 1. Insert a new paragraph 1:
  - "The States Perties to the Covenant undertake to encourage by all appropriate means the conservation, the development and the diffusion of science and culture."
- 2. Renumber paragraph 1 of the emendment as paragraph 2.
- 3. Insert in new peragraph 2 a new sub-paragraph (c):
  - "(c) To enjoy the benefits of scientific progress and its applications."
- 4. Delete paragraph 2 of the amendment.
  - The amendment as amended will then read as follows:
  - "1. The States Parties to the Covenant undertake to encourage by all appropriate means the conservation, the development and the diffusion of science and culture.
  - 2. The States Parties to the Covenant recognize the right of everyone:
    - (a) To take part in cultural life;
    - (b) To enjoy freedom necessary for scientific research and creation:
    - (c) To enjoy the benefits of scientific progress and its applications."
