DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS
AND MEASURES OF IMPLEMENTATION

Poland: amendment to the amendment submitted by the United States
of America (E/CN.4/L.81)

1. Insert a new paragraph 1:

"The States Parties to the Covenant undertake to encourage by all appropriate means the conservation, the development and the diffusion of science and culture."

2. Renumber paragraph 1 of the amendment as paragraph 2.

3. Insert in new paragraph 2 a new sub-paragraph (c):

"(c) To enjoy the benefits of scientific progress and its applications."

4. Delete paragraph 2 of the amendment.

The amendment as amended will then read as follows:

"1. The States Parties to the Covenant undertake to encourage by all appropriate means the conservation, the development and the diffusion of science and culture.

2. The States Parties to the Covenant recognize the right of everyone:

(a) To take part in cultural life;

(b) To enjoy freedom necessary for scientific research and creation;

(c) To enjoy the benefits of scientific progress and its applications."
