## Agenda item 5: Election of the officers of the Main Committees

1. **The Chair** said that the meeting had been convened, in accordance with rules 99 and 103 of the rules of procedure, for the purpose of electing the Chair and other members of the Bureau of the Committee for the sixty-seventh session.

2. Mr. Sergeyev (Ukraine) had been nominated by the Eastern European States for the office of Chair. In the absence of further nominations and in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, he would take it that the Committee wished to elect Mr. Sergeyev (Ukraine) Chair.

3. *Mr. Sergeyev (Ukraine) was elected Chair by acclamation.* 

4. **Mr. Sergeyev** (Ukraine) thanked all States and the Eastern European States in particular for their support. He would work with all Member States to forge universal instruments and to fulfil the goals of the Committee.

5. **The Chair** said that Mr. Bonifaz (Peru), Mr. Chekkori (Morocco) and Mr. Huth (Germany) had been nominated by the Latin American and Caribbean States, the African States and the Western European and Other States, respectively, for the offices of Vice-Chairs.

6. *Mr. Bonifaz (Peru), Mr. Chekkori (Morocco) and Mr. Huth (Germany) were elected Vice-Chairs by acclamation.* 

7. **The Chair** said that the election of the Rapporteur, to be nominated by the Asia-Pacific States, would be held at a later date.
