DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Toxt of article 22 as adopted by the Commission in first reading

ARTICLE 22

- 1. Nothing in this Covenant may be interpreted as implying for any State, group or person any right to engage in any activity or perform any act aimed at the destruction of any of the rights and freedoms defined herein or at their limitation to a greater extent than is already provided for in this Covenant.
- 2. Nothing in this Covenant may be construed as limiting or derogating from any of the rights and freedoms which may be guaranteed under the laws of any Contracting State or any conventions to which it is a party.
