Communiqué of the Community of Latin American and Caribbean States on the acts of terrorism in Boston, United States of America

Havana, 17 April 2013

The Community of Latin American and Caribbean States has learned of the acts of terrorism which took place in Boston, United States of America, on 15 April 2013, claiming lives and leaving over 100 wounded among the civilian population.

The Community of Latin American and Caribbean States, expressing its condolences to the Government and people of the United States of America, and particularly to the families of the victims, reiterates its strongest condemnation of terrorism in all its forms and manifestations, whatever its motivation, and wherever, by whomever and however committed.
