Letter dated 21 June 2013 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2094 (2013), by which the Council decided to extend until 7 April 2014 the mandate of the Panel of Experts, as specified in paragraph 26 of resolution 1874 (2009), and requested the Secretary-General to take the necessary administrative measures to this effect.

In my letter dated 28 March 2013 nominating seven experts (S/2013/199), I announced that an eighth expert would be appointed shortly.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006), I have appointed Neil Watts, expert on maritime transportation (South Africa), to serve on the Panel of Experts.

The Panel is now at its full strength of eight members.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
