CONSTITUTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL REFUGEE ORGANIZATION: AMENDMENT
SUBMITTED BY THE DELEGATION OF THE UNITED KINGDOM

The Secretary-General has received the following letter from the
Delegation of the United Kingdom:

New York, 10 December 1946

"Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that, upon the instructions of
my government, the United Kingdom Delegation wishes to move before
the General Assembly the following amendment to the Constitution of
the International Refugee Organization:

Article 11.

Insert in line 1 after word "Paris":

"or at Geneva, as the General Council shall decide".
