After paragraph 23, insert the following text:

II

Special urgency in the Sudan

The 81st Inter-Parliamentary Conference,

Noting in particular the situation in the Sudan, where 250,000 civilians, the great majority of them children, have died in the past year as a result of armed conflict and where at least 100,000 people face the prospect of certain death this year unless massive relief supplies are delivered before the rainy season begins in May,

Strongly urges the warring parties in the Sudan and the international community to seek without delay a peaceful solution to the conflict and at least assure a month of tranquillity to enable the shipment of necessary relief supplies to reach the affected areas in southern Sudan before the May rains bring internal transportation to a halt.
