## Corrigendum

Replace sub-paragraphs 71 (a), (b) and (c) by the following:

- "(a) The establishment of additional correlated soil surveys and fertility studies combined with crop research would provide essential data for the improvement of agriculture in many areas.
- (b) Surveys of natural grazing lands would indicate how the vegetation should best be managed to provide nutriment for grazing animals and to conserve soil and water. The results of such ecological research could be applied first in demonstrations to grazing communities in pilot areas in many parts of the world leading to widespread agricultural improvements.
- (c) The establishment of veterinary laboratories with equipment for the production of adequate quantities of vaccines to control the prevalent animal diseases, such as rinderpest and foot and mouth disease, will result in gains in the efficiency of livestock production."
