Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/SPC/L.20/Rev.1

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 49th meeting, on 13 December 1984, the Firth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/86) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/SPC/39/L.20/Rev.l. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.49).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 74 to 6, with 15 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/SPC/39/L.20/Rev.l, no additional appropriation would be required under section 27 of the programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985.

4. The voting was as follows:

Against: Belgium, Germany, Federal Republic of, Israel, Netherlands, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining: Australia, Bulgaria, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Canada, Czechoslovakia, France, German Democratic Republic, Hungary, Italy, Japan, Mongolia, New Zealand, Poland, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

5. Statements in explanation of the vote were made by the representatives of the United States of America and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
