

## Report of the open-ended intergovernmental working group on a draft United Nations declaration on the right to peace

## Note by the secretariat

- 1. In its resolution 20/15, the Human Rights Council decided to establish an openended intergovernmental working group, to meet for four working days prior to the twentysecond session of the Council, to progressively negotiate a draft United Nations declaration on the right to peace on the basis of the draft submitted by the Advisory Committee,<sup>1</sup> without prejudging relevant past, present and future views and proposals. The Council requested the Working Group to present a report at its twenty-third session.
- 2. The open-ended working group held its first session from 18 to 21 February 2013. A report was adopted ad referendum at the last meeting of the first session.
- 3. The above-mentioned report of the working group is contained in document A/HRC/WG.13/1/2.
