LETTER DATED 17 OCTOBER 1989 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to inform you that your letter dated 10 October 1989 (S/20905) concerning the increase in the number of electoral supervisors for the forthcoming elections in Namibia has been brought to the attention of the members of the Security Council. They have considered the matter and agreed to the proposal in your letter.

The members of the Security Council expressed their concern that expenditures for the United Nations Transition Assistance Group (UNTAG) should continue to be carefully monitored during this period of increasing demands on peace-keeping resources.
