DELEGATION OF POLAND: PROPOSAL SUBMITTED AT THE FIRST MEETING

- 1. Whereas, the United Nations organization is still at the initial state of its activity, the General Assembly deems it essential for all States Members of the United Nations to seek further strengthening of the United Nations organization and improvement of the work of its bodies in every way. In accordance with the lofty principles and purposes of its Charter which have been recognized by all peace-loving nations.
- 2. The General Assembly expresses the confidence that in the future the Security Council shall duly take into account the experience of its work during the preceding period with a view to secure conditions which would be as favourable as possible to the adoption of agreed decisions, which ensure the prompt and effective exercise by the Security Council of its functions on maintenance of international peace and security and in respect to the peaceful settlement of disputes.
- 3. The General Assembly <u>recommends</u> to the Security Council to take into consideration, while accounting its work, the views expressed by Members of the United Nations during the second part of the first session of the General Assembly.
