CORRIGENDUM TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF THE THIRD MEETING

Held at Lake Success, New York, on Friday, 26 August 1949, at 3 p.m.

Page 5, lines 26-27

Delete the words "an inter-governmental body with consultative status: the South Pacific Commission" and substitute:

"research facilities existing in the South Pacific. In this connexion he referred particularly to the South Pacific Commission which was a co-operative enterprise on the part of six Governments with responsibilities for non-self-governing territories in the area. One of the principal organs of the Commission was a Research Council which would advise member Governments on technical problems and in appropriate cases undertake research."
