CORRIGENDA TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF THE FIFTH MEETING

Held at Lake Success, New York,
on Tuesday, 22 August 1950, at 3 p.m.

Page 10Paragraph 26

Lines 2-5: Replace the words "whose primitive...those Territories." by the words "and he believed that he had a real understanding of the way of life of the peoples concerned."

Line 5: Delete the word "however".

Lines 7-9: Replace the words "a really useful...were absurd." by the words "such a type of education as would pay regard to the principle of adaptation, grafting the new life and culture on to the indigenous stock."

Paragraph 27

Line 4: Replace the word "book" by the word "publication".
Replace "Mr. Williams" by "the late Dr. F.E. Williams".

Line 5: Insert the word "adult" before the word "life".
After the word "Papua" add the words "as Government Anthropologist".
Instead of "The Administering Authorities should be", read:
"The Administering Authorities of Non-Self-Governing Territories might well be".

Line 6: After the word "policies" add the words "and programmes, as he believed was the case with his own Territory of Papua".

/Paragraph 28

Paragraph 28

Line 1:

Delete the words "In conclusion,".

Line 2:

Insert the words "in relation to cultural heritage" after the word "comments".

Line 3:

At the end of the paragraph, add the following sentence:
"He believed that, given the right tools and proper guidance in their use, the indigenous peoples of the Territory he represented would solve the problem of their education in their own effective way, a way which would lead them in due course to full partnership with the Administering Authority in working towards eventual independence, which appeared at present, however, a long way off."
