CORRIGENDA TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF THE TWENTIETH MEETING

Held at Lake Success, New York,
on Tuesday, 5 September 1950, at 11 a.m.

Page 3

Paragraph 2, lines 3-4: Replace the words "application of... Charter", by the words "examination of the information transmitted in accordance with Article 73 e in order to see how far the principles set forth in Chapter XI of the Charter were being applied,".

Page 10

Paragraph 27, line 5: Replace the words "foreign industries" by the words "European enterprises".

Page 12

Paragraph 34, line 2: Replace the word "foreign" by the words "the terms of".

Page 16

Paragraph 50, line 8: Replace the words "international responsibility" by the words "question of international accountability".

Paragraph 53: Replace this paragraph by the following:

"53. He agreed with the representative of Brazil that the main exports of several Non-Self-Governing Territories consisted of only one or two products. It was true that the most satisfactory national economy would aim at a perfect balance between agriculture and industry with exports consisting of an appreciable number of different products both agricultural and industrial. However, in the case of Non-Self-Governing Territories as in other countries geographical and climatic

conditions had to be taken into account. Where there were deposits of certain mineral ores or where the climate favoured the production of certain crops, it was natural that this should be reflected in the exports of the Territory concerned. However the United Kingdom was doing everything in its power to diversify the products exported from Non-Self-Governing Territories, but historical, geographical and climatic conditions had to be taken into account."

Page 17

Paragraph 54

Line 6: After the word "preferable" add the words "because the development of those lands on a large scale had resulted in increased productivity".

Lines 10-12: Replace the last sentence of paragraph 54 by the following:
"Before any alienation of land to non-indigenous peoples could be approved, the interests of the Africans which were paramount had to be carefully considered."
