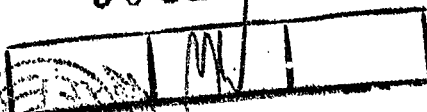

## CORRIGENDUM TO COMMITTEE ON INFORMATION FROM NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES

## Third Session

## SUMMARY RECORD OF THE FIFTY-THIRD MEETING

Held at Headquarters, New York,  
on Friday, 12 September 1952, at 2.30 p.m.

On page 11, substitute the following for paragraph 4:

Mr. RYCKMANS (Belgium) pointed out that FAO was an excellent clearing house for information on the agricultural and nutrition problems being dealt with by many national and international institutions concerned with the African territories. Its representatives, for example, had been present at many international meetings together with representatives of the Belgian Congo, the British dependent territories, etc. It would therefore be of great value to the Committee if the FAO representative could give information showing the nature and scope of the technical assistance given to the Belgian Congo by such active organizations as the Belgian Congo Agricultural Research Institute (INEAC), the IRSAC, the Fonds Cotonnier, the Indigenous Welfare Fund and the Anti-Erosion Mission, among others, in a multitude of fields bearing upon the agricultural development of the territory.
