CORRIGENDUM

Page 3, first paragraph, the last sentence should read:

He would not hesitate to add that in places they could take justifiable pride in the record of their work.

Page 12, the fourth sentence should read:

Hence there was a wide disproportion between the income of Europeans living in the Territories and that of the indigenous inhabitants (£12 per caput for Africans in Kenya in 1957, for example, contrasted with £393 per caput for non-Africans; in Rhodesia and Nyasaland African per caput income was £12 while European per caput income was £611).
