draft decision

The General Assembly,

<u>Decides</u> that the special session of the General Assembly devoted to the question of international co-operation against illicit production, supply, demand, trafficking and distribution of narcotic drugs, with a view to expanding the scope and increasing the effectiveness of such co-operation, shall take place at Headquarters, from 20 to 23 February 1990, under the presidency of the President of the forty-fourth session of the Assembly;

<u>Decides</u> to establish a Preparatory Committee of the Who?e for the special session with one chairman, three vice-chairmen and one rapporteur, which shall meet for two days during the first week of December 1989 and for three days during the first week of February 1990;

<u>Decides</u> that the Bureau of the Preparatory Committee may meet between the sessions of the Preparatory Committee, as required, to advance the preparatory work.
