Elections, nominations, confirmations and appointments

Election of 20 members of the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution [56/206](#), the Economic and Social Council is to elect 20 members of the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme for a four-year term beginning on 1 January 2015 to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2014 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Albania, Algeria, Argentina, Central African Republic, Chile, Finland, Gabon, Grenada, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Japan, Mali, Mozambique, Nigeria, Pakistan, Russian Federation, Sweden, Turkey, United States of America and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of).
2. The election will be held at the coordination and management meetings of the Council, from 23 to 25 April 2014.
3. In accordance with paragraph 4 of section I.A of Assembly resolution [56/206](#), the 20 members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
 - (a) Six seats for African States;
 - (b) Four seats for Asia-Pacific States;
 - (c) Two seats for Eastern European States;
 - (d) Four seats for Latin American and Caribbean States;
 - (e) Four seats for Western European and other States.
4. The membership of the Governing Council in 2014 is listed in the annex to the present note.
