Union of Soviet Socialist Republics: draft resolution

Implementation of General Assembly resolution 42/165

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 42/165 of 11 December 1987,

Noting the report of the Secretary-General on international economic security,  $\underline{1}/$ 

Emphasizing the role of the United Nations and the interest felt by its States Members in strengthening international co-operation for ensuring sustained development, particularly in the developing countries, and balanced growth in the world economy,

- 1. Takes note with appreciation of the work undertaken by the Secretary-General on international economic security;
- 2. Recognizes that the discussions that have taken place on the subject have contributed to growing common understanding of economic interdependence and have played a useful role in the continuing efforts to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of United Nations economic activities and strengthen multilateral co-operation in international economic affairs to the benefit of all countries;

- 3. <u>Emphasizes</u> that constructive, universal and action-oriented dialogue aimed at revitalizing growth and development, in particular the development of developing countries, is essential if effective and co-ordinated approaches to international economic issues are to be found and international peace is to be strengthened;
- 4. <u>Invites</u> relevant organs and organizations of the United Nations and the United Nations system, in accordance with their respective mandates, to consider in their current activities the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Secretary-General; 1/
- 5. Requests the Secretary-General to take the present resolution into account when preparing documentation for the special session of the General Assembly devoted to international economic co-operation, in particular to the revitalization of economic growth and development of the developing countries.
