
<u>Deeply concerned</u> about the serious problem of the illicit production, supply, demand, trafficking and distribution of narcotic drugs and about the devastating effect of drug abuse on individuals and society,

Bearing in mind statements delivered before the Assembly in plenary meeting during its forty-fourth session, including the address given by the President of Colombia on 29 September 1989 1/ and, in particular, his call for a special session of the General Assembly,

- 1. Decides to hold a special session of the General Assembly, at a high political level, to consider as a matter of urgency the question of international co-operation against illicit production, supply, demand, trafficking and distribution of narcotic drugs, with a view to expanding the scope and increasing the effectiveness of such co-operation;
- 2. Requests the Secretary-General to make the necessary administrative arrangements towards the convening of the special session.
