Addendum

- 1. In conformity with article 34 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the thirty-third meeting of the States Parties to the Covenant will be convened by the Secretary-General at United Nations Headquarters on 18 February 2014 for the purpose of electing one member of the Human Rights Committee to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Iulia Antoanella Motoc (Romania).
- 2. By note verbale of 22 November 2013, the Secretary-General invited the States parties to submit nominations, by 22 January 2014, for the purpose of filling the vacancy for a term expiring on 31 December 2014.
- 3. As of 22 January 2014, the curricula vitae of three candidates were received and are annexed to document CCPR/SP/83. The nominations of two of those candidates have since been withdrawn.
- 4. By a note dated 5 February 2014, the Permanent Mission of Montenegro to the United Nations informed the Secretariat that the Government had decided to withdraw the nomination of Ivana Jelic as a candidate for the current election to the Human Rights Committee
- 5. By a note dated 6 February 2014, the Permanent Mission of Kazakhstan to the United Nations informed the Secretariat that the Government had decided to withdraw the nomination of Marat Sarasembayev as a candidate for the current election to the Human Rights Committee.
