

COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS Forty-first session

Item 16 of the provisional agenda

AND PUNISHMENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE SUPPRESSION AND PUNISHMENT OF THE CRIME OF APARTHEID

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with the provisions of its article XV, paragraph 1, the International Convention on the Suppression and Punishment of the Crime of <u>Apartheid</u> entered into force on 18 July 1976, on the thirtieth day after the date of the deposit with the Secretary-General of the twentieth instrument of ratification.

2. As at 1 December 1984, the Convention had been ratified or acceded to by 79 States. A list of States parties to the Convention, as well as the dates of their ratification or accession and the dates of entry into force of the Convention for States concerned, appear in annex I to this note.

3. Under article VII of the Convention, the States parties undertake to submit to the group established under article IX periodic reports on the legislative, judicial, administrative or other measures that they have adopted and that give effect to the provisions of the Convention.

4. In accordance with article IX of the Convention, the Chairman of the Commission on Human Rights is authorized to appoint a group consisting of three members of the Commission, who are also representatives of States parties to the Convention, to consider reports submitted by States parties in accordance with article VII.

5. The Group of Three appointed by the Chairman of the Commission at its thirty-ninth session, held its seventh (1984) session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 50 January to 3 February 1984. It had before it a note by the Secretary-General (E/CN.4/1984/36) concerning the implementation of the Convention, as well as reports submitted by 10 States parties since its sixth (1983) session which were considered by the Group in the presence of the representatives of the reporting States. A list indicating the status of submission of reports by States parties since the entry into force of the Convention and the sessions at which those reports were considered by the Group of Three appears in annex II below.

6. In its report to the Commission on Human Rights at its fortieth session (E/CN.4/1984/48), the Group of Three, inter alia, expressed its appreciation to the representatives of the reporting States for their presence at its meetings and for their participation in its work. The Group considered this practice to be a useful and constructive contribution to its work which should be continued in the future and called upon States to provide in their reports more information on the measures they had adopted to give effect to the provisions of article IV of the

Convention, or on the difficulties which they may have encountered in the implementation of that article. It also drew the attention of the States parties to the importance of article XI of the Convention and invited them to include in their reports more information on their implementation of the provisions of that article.

In its resolution 1984/7 of 28 February 1984, the Commission on Human Rights, 7. inter alia, took note with appreciation of the report of the Group of Three set up under the Convention and in particular the conclusions and recommendations contained in that report; commended those States parties to the Convention"that had submitted periodic reports and called upon those States that have not yet in part done so to submit their reports as soon as possible, in accordance with article VII of the Convention; again urged States which had not yet done so to ratify or accede to the Convention without delay; in particular those States which have jurisdiction over transnational corporations operating in South Africa and in Namibia, and without whese cofforeration such operations could not be halted; recommended once again that all States parties should take full account of the general guidelines laid down by the Group of Three in 1978 for the submission of reports; requested once more the Secretary-General to invite the States parties to submit their views and comments on the interim study (E/CN.4/1426) prepared by the Ad Hoc Working Group of Experts, in accordance with Commission resolution 12 (XXXVI) and to express their views on the extent and the nature of the responsibility of transnational corporations for the continued existence of the system of apartheid in South Africa; requested again the Group of Three to continue examination of the extent and the nature of the responsibility of transmational corporations for the continued existence of the system of apartheid in South Africa, including legal actions that may be taken under the Convention against transnational corporations whose operations in South Africa come under the crime of apartheid, and to report to the Commission at its forty-first session; and decided that the Group of Three shall meet for  $1 \rightarrow \infty \{ \cdot \}$ a period of not more than five days before the forty-first session of the Commission to consider the reports submitted by States parties in accordance with article VII of the Convention. · 是是一个人们的"一个人"的"是个情报的特别。

8. In a series of notes dated 12 June 1984, the Secretary-General brought to the attention of States concerned the relevant provisions of Commission resolution 1984/7 and requested the States parties to the Convention to submit their reports within the time-limits indicated in Commission resolution 7 (XXXIV),  $\frac{1}{}$  and in time for appropriate transmission to the Group of Three at its eighth (1985) session and to the Commission at its forty-first session.

9. By its resolution 39/19 of 23 November 1984, the General Assembly, inter alia, commended those States parties to the Convention that had submitted their reports under article VIT of the Convention; appealed once again to those States that have not yet done so to ratify or to accede to the Convention without further delay, in particular those States which have jurisdiction over transnational corporations operating in South Africa and Namibia; called upon all States parties to the Convention to adopt legislative, judicial and administrative

1/ By its resolution 7 (XXXIV) of 22 February 1978, the Commission on Human Rights called upon the States parties to submit their initial report under article VII of the Convention not later than two years after becoming parties to the Convention and their periodic reports at two-yearly intervals, with the understanding that they may submit additional information to the Group at any time they wished in the intervening period.

measures to prosecute, bring to trial and punish, in accordance with their jurisdiction, persons responsible for, or accused of, the acts enumerated in article II of the Convention; further called upon the States parties to the Convention to submit their opinions on the extent and the nature of the responsibility of transnational corporations for the continued existence of the system of apartheid in South Africa and on the application of article III of the Convention to the activities of those corporations; requested the Secretary-General to intensify his efforts through appropriate channels to disseminate information on the Convention and its implementation with a view to promoting further ratification of or accession to the Convention; requested the Commission on Human Rights to intensify, in co-operation with the Special Committee against Apartheid, its efforts to compile periodically the progressive list of individuals, organizations, institutions and representatives of States deemed responsible for crimes enumerated in article II of the Convention, as well as of those against whom or which legal proceedings have been undertaken; requested the Secretary-General to distribute the above-mentioned list among all States parties to the Convention and all Member States and to bring such facts to the attention of the public by all means of mass communication; and appealed to all States. United Nations organs, specialized agencies and international and national non-governmental organizations to step up their activities in enhancing public awareness through denouncing the crimes committed by the racist regime of South Africa.

10. Since the fortieth session of the Commission, the following States parties to the Convention have submitted their reports: Cuba (E/CN.4/1984/36/Add.9), Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (E/CN.4/1984/36/Add.10), Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic (E/CN.4/1985/26/Add.1), Yugoslavia (E/CN.4/1985/26/Add.2), Algeria (E/CN.4/1985/26/Add.3) and Madagascar (E/CN.4/1985/26/Add.4). These reports will be available to the Group of Three for examination at its eighth (1985) session and to the Commission on Human Rights at its forty-first session. Any other reports which may be received by the Secretary-General before the Commission's session will be issued in further addenda to document E/CN.4/1985/26.
