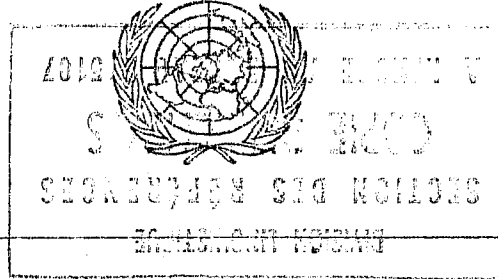
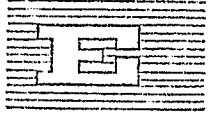

ORGANIZATION OF THE WORK OF THE SESSION

Letter dated 4 February 1985 from the Permanent Representative of Israel to the United Nations Office at Geneva addressed to the Assistant Secretary-General for Human Rights

In accordance with rule 8 of the rules of procedure, the delegation of the State of Israel has the honour to submit proposals for the revision of the provisional agenda of the forty-first session of the Commission on Human Rights by adding two important and urgent items:

1. "The tragic starvation situation in Africa threatening the right to life of millions of human beings and the emergency measures to be taken by the United Nations system on their behalf."

2. "The shortening of the present session in order to release funds to fight the starvation situation prevailing in various parts of the world."

My delegation requests the circulation of these proposals as an official document.
