While the SPT noted as a positive development the recent efforts of the Prosecutor-General to strengthen the oversight over police and to pursue investigations into allegations of torture, this is facing many obstacles in its implementation and of the creation of a Specialized Prosecutors Unit with prosecutorial and investigative functions over cases of torture.
