Delay in publication of preliminary report

The members of the Commission of Inquiry on the Central African Republic have just returned from a two-week tour of the Central African region. The members of the Commission feel that there are new facts on the ground and also, from what they have gathered during the tour, that, to give a true picture of the situation, certain parts of the report have to be revised.

In the circumstances, the Commissioners would ask for the publication of the report to be suspended in order to allow them to give a more precise picture of the situation in the Central African Republic.

The members of the Commission regret any inconvenience caused but believe that, in the interest of a comprehensive and accurate report, this measure is vital.
