## Letter dated 10 July 2014 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to resolution 2157 (2014), by which the Security Council decided to extend the mandate of the United Nations Integrated Peacebuilding Office in Guinea-Bissau (UNIOGBIS) for a period of six months with effect from 1 June 2014.

Following the usual consultations, I wish to inform you of my intention to appoint Miguel Trovoada (Sao Tome and Principe) as my Special Representative in Guinea-Bissau and Head of UNIOGBIS. He will succeed José Ramos-Horta, who has served in that capacity since February 2013 and who concluded his assignment on 30 June 2014. I should like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to Mr. Ramos-Horta for his dedicated service with the United Nations and his effective leadership of UNIOGBIS.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
