## Draft revised calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 2015

### Note by the Secretariat

1. By section I, paragraphs 2 and 3, of General Assembly resolution [68/251](#) of 27 December 2013 on the pattern of conferences, the General Assembly approved the draft biennial calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 2014 and 2015, as submitted by the Committee on Conferences ([A/68/32\\*](#), annex II), and amended by subsequent decisions taken by the Assembly at its sixty-eighth session. The approved calendar was issued as document [A/AC.172/2014/2](#) and Corr.1.

2. In accordance with established practice, the Committee submits to the General Assembly for the second year of each biennium a draft revised calendar that takes into account developments since the adoption of the biennial calendar. In the annex to the present note, the Secretariat submits for consideration by the Committee a draft revised calendar of conferences and meetings. The schedule reflects a number of changes already made during the course of 2014. Other changes for which decisions have yet to be taken or which have yet to be communicated to the Secretariat will be incorporated at a later stage.

3. In considering the draft revised calendar for 2015, the Committee may wish to note the following meetings in particular:

(a) Item 5, “Committee on the Rights of the Child, sixty-eighth session”. In its resolution [67/167](#), paragraph 3, the General Assembly authorized the Committee to meet in parallel chambers, of nine members each, for 13 working days of one of its three regular sessions in 2015, for the purposes of considering the reports of the States parties submitted under article 44 of the Convention, article 8 of the Optional Protocol thereto on the involvement of children in armed conflict<sup>1</sup> and article 12 of

the Optional Protocol thereto on the sale of children, child prostitution and child pornography,<sup>2</sup> taking due account of equitable geographical distribution and the principal legal systems;

(b) Item 158, “International Civil Service Commission, eighty-first session”. In its resolution [40/243](#), section I, paragraph 4 (g), the General Assembly reaffirmed that the Commission should hold its regular annual session at United Nations Headquarters and, if more than one session is required in any one year, may accept an invitation from one of its participating organizations to hold its other session or sessions at the headquarters of that particular organization. It is anticipated that the Commission will hold its fall 2015 session away from United Nations Headquarters, hosted by one of the participating organizations so as to enable the members to familiarize themselves with conditions at other duty stations and to establish contacts with members of legislative bodies of other organizations;

(c) Items [163], “High-level political forum on sustainable development convened under the auspices of the ECOSOC”; [319], “Election of Bureau of the Economic and Social Council”; [320], “Operational activities for development segment”; [321], “Integration segment”; [322], “Humanitarian affairs segment”; [323], “High-level segment”; [324], “Coordination and management meetings”; [325], “Special high-level meetings of the Council with the World Bank, the International Monetary Fund, the World Trade Organization and the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development”; [326], “Partnership forum”; [327], “Youth forum”. In accordance with the annex to General Assembly resolution [68/1](#), schedules for those meetings in 2015 are under consideration by the Economic and Social Council;

(d) Item [341], “Third international conference on financing for development to assess the progress made in the implementation of the Monterrey Consensus and the Doha Declaration on Financing for Development”. In accordance with paragraph 43 of General Assembly resolution [68/204](#), the Conference will be held in 2015 or 2016. A draft resolution on the modalities for the third International Conference on Financing for Development ([A/68/L.49](#)) is under consideration by the General Assembly, in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the Assembly.

4. The Committee’s attention is drawn to the human rights treaty bodies. In its resolution [68/268](#), the General Assembly decided to allocate the addition of meeting time for the following human rights treaty bodies to enable them to address the expected ongoing workload with respect to the review of States party reports and individual communications pursuant to the relevant international conventions on human rights:

- (a) Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination;
- (b) Committee on the Rights of the Child;
- (c) Committee on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families;
- (d) Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women;
- (e) Committee against Torture;

- (f) Human Rights Committee;
- (g) Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights.

5. It should be noted that, in drafting the revised calendar, the Secretariat has taken into account the arrangements referred to in section I, paragraph 4, of resolution [68/251](#) concerning Orthodox Good Friday and the official holidays of Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha. Orthodox Good Friday falls on 10 April 2015. Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha will be observed on 17 July and 23 September 2015, respectively.
