High-level segment: annual ministerial review**Letter dated 6 May 2014 from the Permanent Representative of the Philippines to the United Nations and Chair of the fifty-eighth session of the Commission on the Status of Women addressed to the President of the Economic and Social Council**

In my capacity as Chair of the fifty-eighth session of the Commission on the Status of Women, I have the honour to bring to your attention the Commission's agreed conclusions on its priority theme, "Challenges and achievements in the implementation of the Millennium Development Goals for women and girls", adopted on 21 March 2014 (see [E/2014/27](#)). In adopting the agreed conclusions, the Commission also decided to transmit them to the 2014 high-level segment of the Economic and Social Council, in accordance with General Assembly resolution [68/1](#).

The Commission considered its priority theme during a high-level round table and two interactive panel discussions. The key messages of the discussions are contained in the Chairs' summary and two Moderator's summaries, which may further enrich the deliberations of the Council (see [E/CN.6/2014/INF/2](#), [E/CN.6/2014/INF/3](#) and [E/CN.6/2014/INF/6](#); also available from <http://www.unwomen.org/en/csw/csw58-2014/official-meetings#panelA>).

I would be grateful if the present letter and the agreed conclusions could be brought to the attention of the Council as it considers the theme of its 2014 session.
