ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL LAW COMMISSION

Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary-General has the honour to transmit to the General Assembly the following note verbale, dated 1 April 1976, which he has received from the Permanent Representative of Mexico.

"The Permanent Representative of Mexico presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, in connexion with the election of members of the International Law Commission to be held at the thirty-first regular session of the General Assembly, has the honour to inform him that the Government of Mexico supports the candidacy of Ambassador Zenon Rossides for election to the Commission.

In accordance with articles 4, 5 and 10 of the Statute of the International Law Commission, the Mexican Government nominated four candidates on 25 February 1976, which made it impossible to include the candidacy of Ambassador Rossides. The present note, therefore, is being submitted in place of his nomination."
