Twenty-eighth progress report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Mission in Liberia (S/2014/598)

Letter dated 28 August 2014 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2014/644)

The President: The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2014/664, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by Chad, France, Nigeria, Rwanda, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2014/598, which contains the twenty-

eight progress report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Mission in Liberia.

I also wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2014/644, which contains a letter dated 28 August 2014 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

The President: The draft resolution received 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2176 (2014).
