

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2127 (2013) concerning the Central African Republic

The Permanent Mission of Portugal to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2127 (2013) concerning the Central African Republic and has the honour to refer to the above-mentioned resolution.

The Government of Portugal is fully committed to the implementation of resolution 2127 (2013). In that respect, the legislative measures necessary to implement it (listing of three individuals designated by the Committee) were published on 24 June 2014 (Council Implementing Decision 2014/382/CFSP of 23 June 2014 implementing Decision 2013/798/CFSP concerning restrictive measures against the Central African Republic and Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 691/2014 of 23 June 2014 implementing Article 17 (1) of Regulation (EU) No. 224/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in the Central African Republic). The relevant entities in the Government of Portugal have been notified of the provisions of the resolution.
