Fifth Meeting of States Parties San José, 2-5 September 2014 Item 7 of the provisional agenda* **Adoption of arrangements for meeting the costs of the Meeting**

Estimated costs of the Preparatory Committees of the First Review Conference of the Convention on Cluster Munitions

1. The Fifth Meeting of States Parties to the Convention on Cluster Munitions, held in San José from 2 to 5 September 2014, decided to convene two preparatory meetings of half a day each in Geneva, in February and June 2015, in preparation for the Review Conference of States Parties from 7 to 11 September 2015 in Dubrovnik, Croatia (to be confirmed).


2. The present document is submitted pursuant to the above-mentioned decision of the Fifth Meeting of States Parties and provides estimated costs in the amount of **US\$ 303,000** for convening those meetings. A breakdown of these costs is provided in the tables at the end of the document.

3. It should be noted that the costs are estimated on the basis of past experience and anticipated workload. The actual costs will be determined after the closure of the meeting and the completion of related work, with all relevant expenditures recorded in the accounts. At that time, any adjustments in contributions by the participants sharing the costs will be determined accordingly.

4. With regard to the financial arrangements, it will be recalled that, in accordance with the practice followed on the occasion of multilateral disarmament conferences and related meetings, and as reflected in article 14 of the Convention, the costs are shared among the States parties and observer States participating in the meetings, based on the United Nations scale of assessments prorated to take into account the number of States participating in the meetings.

5. Subject to the approval of the States parties of the estimated costs and costsharing formula, assessment notices will be prepared based on the overall estimated costs and applicable cost-sharing formula. Since the above-mentioned activities shall have no financial implication for the regular budget of the Organization, High Contracting Parties should proceed with the payment of their share of the estimated costs as soon as assessment notices have been received.
