Letter dated 13 May 2014 from the Permanent Representative of Uruguay to the United Nations addressed to the President of the **Economic and Social Council**

I have the honour to write to you in your capacity as President of the Economic and Social Council and, in line with my country's historical commitment to the situation in Haiti, I wish to inform you that Uruguay is interested in joining the Ad Hoc Advisory Group on Haiti.

Uruguay coordinates the Group of Friends of Haiti in New York, contributes troops to the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti and has very close ties with the Haitian people, which the Government of Uruguay wishes to strengthen even further by joining the Ad Hoc Advisory Group on Haiti.

Uruguay believes that the Group's contribution in essential areas such as Haiti's development strategy, socioeconomic recovery, reconstruction and stability has made it a central player.

The Government of Uruguay therefore aligns itself with the aims and commitment of the Ad Hoc Advisory Group on Haiti.
