


- 1. At its 46th and 47th meetings, on 25 and 30 June 2014, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/68/24) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/68/L.49. At the 46th meeting, the Chair of the Committee drew the attention of the Committee to the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/68/7/Add.29) and to the statement by the Chair. The Committee had before it a draft decision (A/C.5/68/L.41) submitted by the Chair following informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Sweden (see para. 3).
- 2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/68/SR.46 and 47).

Decision of the Fifth Committee

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General¹ and the related report of the

Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,² decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/68/L.49, additional resources amounting to 1,504,700 United States dollars would be required under section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management, of the programme budget for the biennium 2014-2015, representing a charge against the contingency fund.
