[24 October 1989]

- On 19 October 1989, at 12.50 p.m. Moscow time, an underground nuclear explosion with a yield of between 20 and 75 kilotons was conducted in the Soviet Union at a test site in the Semipalatinsk region.
- The test was conducted with a view to refining military technology.
- Radiation levels at the test area and outside the test site are normal.
