The situation in the Central African Republic

Letter dated 28 October 2014 from the Panel of Experts on the Central African Republic established pursuant to Security Council resolution 2127 (2013) addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2014/762)

The President (*spoke in Spanish*): The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2015/43, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by France.

I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2014/762, which contains a letter dated 28 October 2014 from the Panel of Experts on

the Central African Republic established pursuant to Security Council resolution 2127 (2013) addressed to the President of the Security Council.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour:

Angola, Chad, Chile, China, France, Jordan, Lithuania, Malaysia, New Zealand, Nigeria, Russian Federation, Spain, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela

The President (*spoke in Spanish*): The draft resolution received 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2196 (2015).

The Security Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on its agenda.
